

Notice of the Club Championship Regatta Series

Harper Lake Model Yacht Club

Harper Lake Model Yacht Club conducts an annual Club Championship Regatta series consisting of monthly regattas for both the Victoria and ODOM RC yachts. Race results from monthly regattas are cumulatively tabulated to determine annual standings for all members including the club champion. The club also hosts the Rocky Mountain Regattas each year for both classes of yachts on dates that are scheduled for the regular club series regattas. Rocky Mountain Regatta race scores are included in the cumulative results for the Club Championship Regatta for eligible skippers.

Eligibility: Members of the Harper Lake Model Yacht Club sailing Victoria and/or ODOM Class yachts are eligible to participate in the Club Championship Regatta Series. Participation is limited to the frequencies available with no limit on 2.4GHz. Invited guests may participate in a regatta, but their race results will be scored but not tabulated in the annual series.

Entry: Any eligible member may enter each monthly regatta by paying their annual club dues and showing up at the lake with the right boat on the right day, as per the schedule below. To participate in a Victoria regatta you must sail a Victoria. To participate in an ODOM regatta you must sail an ODOM.

Entry Fee: There is no entry fee for each regatta, with the exception of the two Rocky Mountain Regattas (Victoria and ODOM) for which there may or may not be an entry fee, although full participation is limited to club members in good standing who have paid their annual dues.

Measurement: Measurement may be conducted at any time, on a random basis, as decided by a consensus of the club officers or the Regatta Chairman for the Rocky Mountain Regattas.

Schedule of Events:

Victoria Class

The First Saturday of each month, April through November, weather permitting

10:00 am Course set up, boat tuning and race preparation

10:30 am Start Racing

1:00 pm End of Racing (no race may be started after 12:59 pm)

ODOM Class

The Third Saturday of each month, April through November, weather permitting

10:00 am Course set up, boat tuning and race preparation

10:30 am Start Racing

1:00 pm End of Racing (no race may be started after 12:59 pm)

Note 1: Each year, the secretary will post the dates for each monthly regatta.

Note 2: Race dates may be changed to accommodate holidays and other significant conflicts at the discretion and with the consensus of the club officers.

Note 3: The time schedule for the Rocky Mountain Regatta will supersede the regular

Victoria and ODOM time schedules

Scoring: Each race of each regatta will be scored [using the low point scoring system](#). Each regatta score for all eligible skippers will be combined with all other regatta scores earned in this annual series, including scores earned in the respective Rocky Mountain Regattas. The cumulative result of the scores of the season will result in the club championship. Harper Lake Model Yacht Club does not hold a single event as a championship regatta. The annual Club Championship Regatta Series and ranking is wholly based on the cumulative results of the annual regatta series.

Scores earned in the Rocky Mountain Regattas will be used both to determine the ranking for those individual events AND as a part of the cumulative results of the annual regatta series for eligible club members. And, as noted above, invited guests may participate in any other regatta, but their race results will not be scored (except for the Rocky Mountain Regattas).

Only the five best regatta scores of the season for each skipper will be counted in the cumulative total of all the regattas to determine annual standings, regardless of how many regattas are actually held. The maximum number of regattas to be held in one season will be eight (held during the months of April through November) but may be fewer depending on the weather.

Sailing Instructions:

A copy of the Sailing Instructions are posted at the HLMYC web site. There will be no appeal of a protest committee decision if that appeal could affect any boat's promotion or relegation.

Regatta Site: The regatta site will be at Harper Lake in the city of Louisville, Colorado.

Sail Numbering: The visibility and readability of your sails will be scrutinized and/or tested during check-in.

Prizes: AMYA black chevrons and individual awards will be awarded to the three top finishing positions each year for each class.
