

Because of the ongoing concern for everyone's health in the club and the community, we will be implementing the following rules during this pandemic:

- 1) Skippers will be encouraged to maintain 6 feet social distancing from each other while at the lake. Personal chairs will be placed 6 feet apart on the lake shore.
- 2) In order to help keep the social distancing of 6 feet, skippers will not walk up and down the shore while their boats are sailing as they usually do. Skippers will need to remain seated or standing in the immediate vicinity of their chair while racing.
- 3) Even though we are outside, we will be stationary for long periods of time. Masks or face coverings are required to be worn at all times to help protect those in our club who are at-risk, which is almost everyone.
- 4) Skippers will continue to follow the standard rules at Harper Lake also, such as no skin contact with the water.

Since the situation with this virus is constantly changing, we will continue to monitor the situation and if it is deemed unsafe for us to gather for sailing activities we will suspend sailing.
